5:11-12 Kings But Ш Naaman was furious and went away and said. "Behold, I thought, 'He will surely come out to me, and stand and call on the name of the LORD his God, and wave his hand over the place, and cure the leper.' Are not Abanah and Pharpar. the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Could I not wash in them and be clean?" So he turned and went away in a rage.

Jonah

Jonah 4:8-9 And it came about when the sun came up that God appointed a scorching east wind, and the sun beat down on Jonah's head so that he became faint and begged with all his soul to die, saying, "Death is better to me than life." Then God said to Jonah, "Do you have good reason to be angry about the plant?" And he said, "I have good reason to be angry, even to death."

The disciples at the outcry of the Canaanite woman

Matthew 15:23 But He did not answer her a word. And His disciples came to Him and kept asking Him, saying, "Send her away, for she is shouting out after us."

James and John at the inhospitality of the Samaritans

Luke 9:54 And when His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?"

Martha with her sister Mary

Luke 10:40 But Martha was distracted with all her preparations; and she came up to Him, and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to do all the serving alone? Then tell her to help me."

GENERAL REFERENCES

Isaiah 59:8 They do not know the way of peace, and there is no justice in their tracks; they have made their paths crooked; whoever treads on them does not know peace.

Jeremiah 5:4 Then I said, "They are only the poor, they are foolish; for they do not know the way of the LORD or the ordinance of their God.

Amos 3:10 "But they do not know how to do what is right," declares the LORD, "these who hoard up violence and devastation in their citadels."

Micah 4:12 "But they do not know the thoughts of the LORD, and they do not understand His purpose; for He has gathered them like sheaves to the threshing floor.

IGNORANCE OF GOD

Judges 2:10 And all that generation also were gathered to their fathers; and there arose another generation after them who did not know the LORD, nor yet the work which He had done for Israel.

Jeremiah 4:22 "For My people are foolish, they know Me not; they are stupid children, and they have no understanding. They are shrewd to do evil, but to do good they do not know."

Jeremiah 8:7 "Even the stork in the sky knows her seasons; and the turtledove and the swift and the thrush observe the time of their migration; but My people do not know the ordinance of the LORD.

John 15:21 But all these things they will do to you for My name's sake, because they do not know the One who sent Me.

Acts 17:23 For while I was passing through and examining the objects of your worship, I also found an altar with this inscription, 'To an unknown God.' What therefore you worship in ignorance, this I proclaim to you.

IGNORANCE CONCERNING CHRIST

John 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

John 4:10 Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water." John 8:19 And so they were saying to Him, "Where is Your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither Me, nor My Father; if you knew Me, you would know My Father also."

John 9:30 The man answered and said to them, "Well, here is an amazing thing, that you do not know where He is from, and yet He opened my eyes.

Acts 13:27 For those who live in Jerusalem, and their rulers, recognizing neither Him nor the utterances of the prophets which are read every Sabbath, fulfilled these by condemning Him.

WILLFUL IGNORANCE

Job 21:14 And they say to God, 'Depart from us! We do not even desire the knowledge of Thy ways.

Zechariah 7:11-12 But they refused to pay attention, and turned a stubborn shoulder and stopped their ears from hearing. And they made their hearts like flint so that they could not hear the law and the words which the LORD of hosts had sent by His Spirit through the former prophets; therefore great wrath came from the LORD of hosts.

Matthew 13:15 For the heart of this people has become dull, and with their ears they scarcely hear, and they have closed their eyes lest they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart and return, and I should heal them.

Romans 1:28 And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper.

II Peter 3:5 For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word

of God the heavens existed long ago and the earth was formed out of water and by water.

Mark 5:19 And He did not let him, but He said to him, "Go home to your people and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He had mercy on you."

Christ's message grounded in experience

John 3:10-11 Jesus answered and said to him, "Are you the teacher of Israel, and do not understand these things? "Truly, truly, I say to you, we speak that which we know, and bear witness of that which we have seen: and you do not receive our witness.

Qualified the blind man to testify

John 9:25 He therefore answered, "Whether He is a sinner, I do not know; one thing I do know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see."

Fitted Paul for a ministry of comfort

II Corinthians 1:4 Who comforts us in all our affliction so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

Enabled the Apostles to speak with authority

II Peter 1:16 For we did not follow cleverly devised tales when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty.

Seeking Instruction

Mark 7:17 And when leaving the multitude, He had entered the house, His disciples questioned Him about the parable.

Mark 9:11 And they asked Him, saying, "Why is it that the scribes say that Elijah must come first?"

Mark 9:28 And when He had come into the house, His disciples began questioning Him privately, "Why could we not cast it out?"

Mark 10:10 And in the house the disciples began questioning Him about this again.

Mark 13:4 "Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign when all these things are going to be fulfilled?" Luke 3:12 And some taxgatherers also came to be baptized, and they said to him, "Teacher, what shall we do?"

Luke 11:1 And it came about that while He was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John also taught his disciples."

Luke 18:18 And a certain ruler questioned Him, saying, "Good Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"
